

HANGING INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAPER BACKED TEXTILE WALLCOVERINGS

Important Notice

- Many of the above imported natural wallcoverings are handcrafted from natural materials and finished with color washes.
- > These materials are fragile, exercise care in handling to avoid damage. Avoid folding or creasing which may create markings on the product. No adjustment or claim will be considered because of variation in color or shading once material has been cut.
- > There are often slight irregularities in the natural fibers and coloration. Seams may be obvious upon installation and there will be a panel effect. This variation is the natural characteristic of these wallcoverings and it is not considered a defect.
- > All rolls must have the same production number. Hang in sequence as cut from bolt starting with the highest first.
- WALLS MUST BE PROPERLY SIZED. AFTER WALLS ARE PROPERLY PRIMED, ROLL OUT ONE COAT OF ADHESIVE AND ALLOW TO DRY. This will help protect any puckering from shrinkage of the paper backing.

Prior to Installation

- Examine each roll to be sure the product is what was ordered. Each bolt should be rolled out so color and shading can be examined to your satisfaction.
- > Carefully inspect the installation after applying three strips before proceeding. If, at any time during the installation, a discrepancy occurs, stop. Contact the designer or thesign before proceeding.

Wall Preparation

- > Proper wall preparation is essential. Generally, they must be smooth and clean. Wallcoverings will not adhere to dirt, soap or grease.
- > Remove all old wallcoverings. Clean walls. Prepare with wallcovering primer. If working around switch plates turn off electricity.
- Remove any loose or flaking paint and fill cracks with packing compound.
- > Sand to a smooth finish, sand off bumps. This material may telegraph defects on the wall so walls must be smooth.
- > Always apply a single coat of pigmented sealer on new and unpainted walls followed by a wallcovering primer / sizing, such as Romans R-35.
- > AFTER WALLS ARE PROPERLY PRIMED, ROLL OUT ONE COAT OF ADHESIVE AND ALLOW TO DRY.

Important Notes for Application

- · A pre-mixed, non-staining, clear, non strippable water-based adhesive should be used, read the label. Apply paste with roller to ensure even application taking care not to get adhesive on surface. Do not use a pasting machine. Booking vary with backing and climate. Paste and hang one strip at a time. Avoid excessive soaking. Treat your product with extreme care.
- Installation by straight up or reverse hanging are down to personal preference. Panelling will be more obvious with reverse hangs.
- \cdot Wallcoverings are pre-trimmed and can be butt jointed. Equally, it is possible to overlap and double cut the joints, use a new sharp blade is used for each cut.
- · Avoid the use of a hard roller or overworking on the seams as this may damage the edges. Use a soft rubber roller if necessary.
- · All seams should be taped using **only low adhesive tape (safe release tape)**, such as 3M Blue tape 1 1/2", to keep the face of the seams clean. Smooth material to hanging surface with a soft bristle brush to ensure good adhesion.
- If you have an external corner the material should be wrapped around by at least 25cm (10").

AFTER APPLYING THREE STRIPS, if there are any variations in color and or pattern match, please contact us immediately for inspection. Do not proceed. Natural wallcoverings do however tend to panel lightly on occasion.

Do not hang more than 3 strips. Carefully inspect the installation of the 3 strips before proceeding. If at anytime during the installation a discrepancy occurs, stop to contact the designer or thesign.

PASTE: something the installer has to decide with their experience. Pastes we have worked with include Tekfix Plus and Brewers Red Lid.

DO NOT USE A PASTING MACHINE WITH THIS PRODUCT.
